Have you accumulated old paint, pesticides, or other dangerous chemicals in your shed, garage, or some other storage area? We can help! As a service to residents, Monroe County now offers three locations where you can get rid of these hazardous chemicals – FREE OF CHARGE! Besides serving households, these three locations are also open to businesses that generate less than 100 kilograms of hazardous waste per month for a reduced fee of \$0.60/pound, contaminated petroleum @ \$0.60/gallon. We accept the following wastes:

- Latex and oil-based paints and stains
- Paint thinners, strippers and reducers
- Household cleaning products
- Car and boat waxes and polishes
- Batteries (car, boat, or household)
- Corrosives (i.e. muriatic acid, lye, etc.)
- Adhesives, putty and caulk
- Roof tar and patching compounds
- Used oil/hydraulic fluids
- Pesticides and fertilizers
- Contaminated gasoline
- Pool cleaning products
- Solvents
- Fiberglass resins
- Antifreeze
- Wood preservatives

Unfortunately, we **CANNOT** accept the following wastes:

- x Explosives
- x Asbestos
- x Radioactive wastes
- x Biohazards

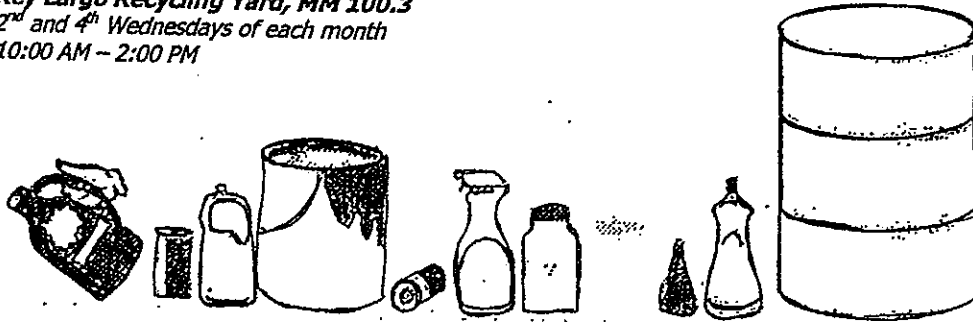
ALSO being accepted from homeowners all types of electronics (computer equipment, cell phones, televisions, etc.)
